What meaning does Remembrance Day have for you?

On Remembrance Day, we acknowledge the courage and sacrifice of those who served their country and acknowledge our responsibility to work for the peace they fought hard to achieve. During times of war, individual acts of heroism occur frequently; only a few are ever recorded and receive official recognition.

What is Remembrance Day and why do we celebrate it?


Armistice Day, or Remembrance Day as it's also known, **marks the very day that World War One ended in 1918**. We hold a two-minute silence at 11am on the 11th day of the 11th month to remember those who have died in any conflict.

Who do we remember on Remembrance Day?

The anniversary is used to remember all the people who have died in wars not just World War One. This includes World War Two, the Falklands War, the Gulf War, and conflicts in Afghanistan and Iraq.

Why do we wear poppies?

The poppy is **the enduring symbol of remembrance of the First World War**. Artificial poppies were first sold in Britain in 1921 to raise money for the Earl Haig Fund in support of ex-servicemen and the families of those who had died in the conflict.



The reason poppies are used to remember those who have given their lives in battle is **because they are the flowers which grew on the battlefields after World War One ended**. This is described in the famous World War One poem In Flanders Fields. ... It is also used to help those who have lost loved ones because of wars.

What is the act of remembrance?

The Act of Remembrance is **brief and non-religious**, making it exceptionally well-suited to personalized commemorations. You may assemble whatever readings, music or other elements you wish to accompany the Act of Remembrance in order to make your own ceremony or event relevant to your particular community.



The **2021 POPPY CAMPAIGN** in K-W runs Friday, October 29 to Thursday, November 11, 2021. Remembrance Day Ceremonies in both Kitchener and Waterloo are scaled down due to COVID-19 restrictions. There are no parades.

Veterans Affairs Canada announced this year's theme for <u>Veterans' Week from November 5 to 11</u> is "Service, courage and sacrifice—at home, around the world and across generations."


BARRELS OF OIL
