

“The Royal Canadian Air Force (RCAF) has entered into the storied pages of history after setting a record for illuminating the most landmarks around the world in 24 hours.

The prestigious Guinness World Record recognized the efforts of the RCAF after setting a world record on April 1, 2024.

The Guinness World Record was set in recognition of the RCAF’s centennial anniversary.

“We are incredibly proud to have set this Guinness World Record. This illumination event was a visual spectacle and a heartfelt tribute to RCAF personnel, past and present, who have served our country with distinction. We are grateful to all Canadians and our global partners who participated and helped us light up the nation and the world in celebration of our Centennial,” said LGen. Eric Kenny, Commander of the RCAF and Chief of Air Force Staff.

The record was set with 56 landmarks illuminated in 24 hours. The previous record was 38 illuminated landmarks. Moreover, over 500 sites, including landmarks, were illuminated worldwide.”

Remembering Linda

Family, friends and a long list of acquaintances who had been privileged to know her were saddened by the loss of Linda (Boland) Brimson in June. Many others who never met her, benefitted from her long hours of dedicated volunteer work.

I met Linda, then a phototypesetter with Murray Kelly Printing on Adelaide Street, when hired as a proofreader, about 1975. Linda patiently taught me how to mark up a 'galley proof' (this was before the advent of desktop publishing, PDFs and email) with standard proofreading marks and a red pen.

Here's just one of many stories of how a moment's thoughtfulness from Linda could have long-ranging impact on others: Some 20 years after we worked together at Murray Kelly's when Linda was working in the pre-press department at London Life and I had worked in various design agencies, newspapers and print shops, she called to say that Diamond Aircraft had posted a job opening for a graphic artist / marketing coordinator that she felt was meant for me. She was right: I worked 18 years there.


At age 50, Linda changed career direction, became a Registered Nurse and worked at The Sisters of St. Joseph until just recently retiring.

Retire? Hardly. With her life-long interest in local history – especially rural and aviation history – and writing, work ethic and natural generosity of spirit, Linda devoted countless hours of volunteer work for the RCAFA 427 (London) Wing, the Canadian Harvard Aircraft Association (CHAA), Re-Forest London and others. As an article contributor to the 427 Wing newsletter and as author of *The CHAA Story*, she helped preserve local history. A hard worker, she took on the tedious in-depth tasks of writing proposals for government funding for 427 Wing and developing fundraising campaigns, as well as the more fun chores of event planning. Her 2022 calendar featuring 427 Wing history was a big hit.

"Linda contributed greatly to the 427 (London) Wing, said Jim Donnelly. "She led the organization through some very difficult times in recent years. As a new Chairperson, whenever I reached out to Linda she freely answered my questions and did her best to assist myself and the RCAFA organization. She will be missed by all at the 427 Wing."

Of course, family was always foremost. Linda was the dear mother of Trevor and proud grandmother of four. Trevor recalls that she was the 'Baseball Mom' who brought water, popsicles and snacks for the team. Linda is also survived by her mother Theresa Boland, her three brothers and their wives, and her nieces and nephews.

"Mom did a lot during her 69 years with us," says Trevor. "She accomplished a great many things, she met an even greater number of people but most of all she touched all our lives in some way and we're all better for having known her."
