#### **ROYAL CANADIAN AIR FORCE NEWS**

On April 1<sup>st</sup> 2020, the RCAF marked 96 years of service. In 1917, the era of military aviation dawned in Canada with the establishment of the Royal Flying Corps Canada (RFCC) in southern Ontario. Camp Borden – now Canadian Forces Base Borden – in Ontario was the RFCC's main base.
